**ITEM 1607-19: Approving an Amendment to the FY 2016-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Adding Broadway/Seashore Road (CR 626) Resurfacing in Cape May County**

### **PROPOSAL**

At its July 11, 2016 meeting, the Technical Advisory Committee recommended that the Policy Board approve an amendment to add a new project to the FY 2016-2025 TIP.

### **PROJECT**

**DB# S1701** – Broadway/Seashore Road (CR626), Sunset Boulevard/West Perry Street to Route 9 in the Borough of West Cape May and Lower Township. The project is seeking construction funding in FY 2017 in the amount of \$1.33 million.

### **BACKGROUND**

Cape May County has requested this amendment because the roadway is in poor condition and is in need of repair, supported by the pavement management system assessment completed in 2012. The shoulders of Seashore Road from Stimpson Lane to Jonathan Hoffman are marked and signed as bike lanes and will continue to be after this improvement project. The construction will be funded with Federal Repurposing Funds in the amount of \$1.33 million.

The addition of this project to the current TIP will not have a negative impact on the air quality in the region.

This project is being funded with Federal Repurposing funds thus maintaining fiscal constraint.



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**RESOLUTION 1607-19: Approving an Amendment to the FY 2016-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Adding Broadway/Seashore Road (CR 626) Resurfacing in Cape May County**

**WHEREAS, the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization (SJTPPO) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) designated under federal law for the southern region of New Jersey including Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland, and Salem Counties; and**

**WHEREAS, MPO's are responsible for developing a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that sets forth the capital expenditures for at least four years, as required by the Federal Metropolitan Planning Rule (23 CFR 450C and 49 CFR 613C); and**

**WHEREAS, Cape May County has requested an amendment to the FY 2016-2015 TIP to add the Broadway/Seashore Road (CR626), resurfacing project in FY 2017; and**

**WHEREAS, the construction will be funded with Federal Repurposing Funds in the amount of \$1,330,000 thus maintaining fiscal constraint; and**

**WHEREAS, the addition of this project to the TIP will not have a negative impact on the air quality in the region; and**

**WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT), New Jersey Transit, and SJTPPO have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Procedures to Amend and Modify the SJTPPO TIP and the State TIP; and**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Policy Board of the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization hereby amends the FY 2016-2025 Transportation Improvement Program to add the above project in FY 2017.**
