Questions and Answers

Q1: Is a Concept Development Report to be prepared by the selected consultant as part of this scope?

A1: A Final Report will be prepared by the consultant that includes the work items detailed in Task 3. An NJDOT-format Concept Development Report is not required.

Q2: Do you anticipate that there be Public Involvement meetings?

A2: No, not as part of this technical study.

Q3: Is base mapping of Burns Avenue available or will survey and base mapping tasks be required as part of the RFP?

A3: Surveying and base mapping are not required for this project. The City of Vineland will provide the selected consultant with a .pdf copy of the design plans from the Burns Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension. These plans were completed in 2013 and cover the extent of the Burns Avenue Concept Development study area.
