Questions and Answers

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**Q1. Is pavement surface condition data required or only IRI?**

A1. Only IRI is required by the RFP. Additional data collection may be proposed, but is not required.

**Q2. If pavement surface condition data is collected, do you want some type of numerical rating for each road (PCI, or equivalent)?**

A2. If pavement surface condition is provided in addition to the IRI, then the consultant may include a numerical rating for roadway surface condition.

**Q3. Is it acceptable to use a DBE firm that doesn't have a FAR overhead audit? (they would do their work on a lump sum basis as a sub to the prime who does have a FAR overhead rate)**

A3. A DBE firm is not required to have a FAR overhead audit. However, a DBE firm must be certified through the NJ Unified Certification Program.

**Q4. Does the City of Vineland currently utilize any type of Pavement Management System?**

A4. No, the City of Vineland does not currently utilize a Pavement Management System.
