

Projects Approved for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2022-2024 Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) Funding

Pacific Avenue Signal Optimization

Project Sponsor: Atlantic City

Project Description: Installation of traffic signal system for synchronization: Pacific Ave from Hartford Ave to Massachusetts Ave; Tennessee Ave to Atlantic City – City Hall to Pacific Ave; and Iowa Ave Atlantic City Public Safety Building to Pacific Ave

Funding Received: \$200,000 in FFY 2022 for Design & \$1.2M in FFY 2024 for Construction

Somers Point Bike Path Enhancements

Project Sponsor: Somers Point

Project Description: Installation of amenities along the Somers Point Bike Path, including flashing beacons at crosswalks; 4 pedestrian and bicycle counters; 6 bicycle repair stands; 20 wayfinding signs; 10 bike racks; and 10 benches

Funding Received: \$165,000 in FFY 2022

Ventnor Avenue Signal Synchronization Project

Project Sponsor: City of Ventnor

Project Description: Installation of traffic signal system for synchronization; Ventnor Ave between Oxford Ave and Baton Rouge Ave

Funding Received: \$290,000 in FFY 2022 for Design & \$1.35M in FFY 2023 for Construction

“To-Work” Transportation Vehicle Replacement project

Project Sponsor: Cumberland County Department of Workforce Development

Project Description: Procurement of 5 low-emission, unleaded fuel, body on chassis minibuses, to replace older models that will reach the end of their useful life by the end of 2023

Funding Received: \$350,000 in FFY 2023

Vineland Alternative Fuel Vehicles

Project Sponsor: City of Vineland

Project Description: Acquisition of 12 Ford Escape SE Plug-In Hybrids to replace current fleet; 12 level 2 charging stations to be installed next to City Hall; 2 aerial bucket utility trucks for the City of Vineland Electric Utility; and 2 fast charging stations to be installed at the City Garage

Funding Received: \$200,000 in FFY 2023 & \$200,000 in FFY 2024

Roosevelt Boulevard/34th Street Advanced Traffic Signal Project

Project Sponsor: Cape May County

Project Description: Construction of interconnection of advanced system equipment at 7 signalized intersections along Cape May County CR 623 (Roosevelt Blvd and 34th St)

Funding Received: \$500,000 in FFY 2024
