Pedestrian improvements at signalized intersections will include adding or reconstructing curb ramps; pedestrian push buttons and countdown "man/hand" type signal heads and crosswalks. Driveways will be re-graded if adjacent to non-compliant curb ramps, or where a pedestrian access route (PAR) is not provided across the driveway. ROW acquisition may be needed to construct the curb ramps as described. In addition, in order to correct non-compliant grading reconstruction to lessen slopes will extend beyond the existing ROW line to bring project Rt. 30 and Pomona Rd. into compliance with current ADA standards.

This project is being proposed in concert with another project, the raising of the easterly portion of 34th Street as part of a joint venture between the County and City. The expectation is that the roadway will be elevated approximately 12" to provide for added evacuation servcibility while not adversely impacting business access. The roadway is also of critical importance as it is listed as an NHS route. The roadway is classified as a Rural Principal Collector.

The project will accomodate bike traffic that curenly travels along the corridor to reach the business district of Bayshore road to the east, and the beach of the Delaware Bay to the west. Townbank road provides tourist access to the businesses and the Cape May Beach section of the township primarily consists of second homes. The demographics of population fronting Townbank Road include multi-cultural/ multi ethnic individuals. Many of the residents are of low to moderate income and as a result the roadway sevicees both vehiclualr, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic.
